### **SITUATION**

The USB Audio Interface is only available as a factory installed option. It **cannot** be retrofited as an Aftersales accessory. It is recommended that all supported iPod devices be used in conjunction with the Y-Cable.

## Supported and compatible devices:

- Apple iPod from 4th generation onwards
- iPod nano
- iPod mini
- MP3 players
- USB flash drive only (aka: "USB memory stick")

It is possible to access all stored audio data directly through a play list, as well as searching for genre, artist, album or title. However, sorting and displaying of audio files in the vehicle can only be carried out correctly if all data stored on the MP3 player (e.g. ID3 tags) contain Roman characters exclusively. Play lists must contain absolute path indications if the audio file is not located in the same directory as the play list itself (e.g. /dir1/dir2/track.mp3).

#### **IMPORTANT:**

- Only audio files are played. Accessing other files (such as videos) is not possible. Due to the variety of MP3 players and USB memory sticks and their technical differences, the flawless operation with the USB audio interface cannot be guaranteed for all devices.
- The playing of audio files through mobile phones equipped with a USB is not recommended through the USB audio interface. The receiving or placing of phone calls cannot be guaranteed as some handsets render Bluetooth functionality inactive when a USB connection is established.

# Apple iPod Y-Adapter Cable (30-pin-connector to USB and AUX-in)

The Y-Adapter consists of an auxiliary and USB input for use with the Apple iPod. Full iPod integration can only be achieved with the use of the Y-Adapter. This device is not included as part of option SA 6FL but can be purchased separately (Part number: 61 12 0 422 099). The Y-Adapater is only available from BMW.

## **Supported Devices:**

## 1) Apple iPods

- iPod (with hard disk) from 4th Generation devices on, i.e. iPod with Click Wheel, iPod with color display (including iPod photo) and iPod Video.
- iPod nano (with flash storage) 1st and 2nd Generation devices.
- iPod mini (with fixed hard disk) 1st and 2nd Generation devices.
- iPod shuffle (with flash storage).

#### Note:

- No support of prior models with Scroll Wheel or Touch Wheel.
- When the iPod is connected to iTunes through a PC, iTunes is capable of automatically
  updating the iPod software, which may cause an impact on the interaction of the iPod with
  the USB audio interface.
- iPod devices can be disconnected from the vehicle at any time.

### 2) MP3 Players

Devices with the "PlaysForSure" logo are not supported with the USB audio interface as they support the "Media Transfer Protocol" (MTB). To configure the device for "USB Mass Storage" mode, refer to the MP3 player owner's manual.

**Note:** The device must also be formatted with the FAT file system. Refer to Table 1.

When the device is initially connected to the vehicle, a database will be assembled, allowing users to access play lists and search by genre, artist, album and title. The synchronisation of an MP3 player with 8 GB of flash storage takes up to 10 minutes; longer synchronisation times may occur depending on device characteristics. During this time, music titles can be selected through indices and file names.

## 3) USB flash drives (aka: "USB memory stick"):

Only USB memory sticks formatted in the FAT format (usually the default setting) are supported.

**Note:** USB hard disks, hubs and/or card reader with several inputs are not supported.

After initial connection of the USB stick with the vehicle, a database will be assembled based on the file information of the available music titles. This allows access to play lists or search by genre, artist, album and title.

The synchronisation of a USB stick with 8 GB of flash storage may take up to 10 minutes; longer synchronisation times may be due to device specific limitations. During the synchronization period music titles can be selected through indices and file names.

**Storage of the device and first installation:** It is recommended that MP3 players or USB memory sticks are not left unattended in the vehicle for extended periods of time. Extreme environmental conditions (i.e. temperature, humidity) may damage the device.

The performance of the MP3 player or USB memory stick such as duration of synchronisation or operating speeds depends on:

- Device storage capacity.
- Number of songs and varying file formats stored on the device.

### TROUBLESHOOTING

## Complaints which are caused by the design of the USB Audio Interface:

- Q: The connected USB device is not recognized and cannot be selected as an entertainment source?
  - **A:** Not all USB devices are compatible with option 6FL. Please refer to the latest list of compatible/recommended USB devices. Refer to the attached compatibility chart.
- Q: Why are specific tracks not played?
   A: The file has an invalid format (not mp3, wma or aac), has been corrupted or is digitally incripted (i.e. AAC). Note, for AAC files the Y-Cable is required.
- Q: Play lists, genres, artists, albums and tracks on USB devices are not displayed?
   A: Only Roman text characters are supported. Other character sets (Greek, Japanese, etc.) cannot be displayed.
- Q: Why does the time it takes to display play lists, genres, artists, albums and tracks on USB devices vary for different devices?
   A: This is dependent upon the number of stored audio files. In the case of a device with
  - 8 GB storage, it would take approximately 10 minutes. In the case of a device with
- **Q:** Why do I experience distortion through the audio system when the device is connected to the cigar lighter for charging?
  - **A:** Audio interference may occur if a device is connected to both the USB interface and the 12V socket. Depending on the model, the USB devices may be supplied with power by the USB interface itself. In such cases, no additional power connection is required.
- Q: Why is the browsing history not stored in some vehicle?
  A: With the CCC head unit, browsing history is not stored. For example, if one scans through the list of artists, the cursor will appear at the top of the menu upon return to the artist's sub-menu.

## Open issues currently being worked on.

- **Problem:** Message "No supported audio files found" is displayed when a play list is selected.
  - **Solution:** If play lists and audio files are stored in different folders, absolute paths must be used, e.g. /dir1/dir2/track.mp3.
- Problem: Intermittent: Unable to select/activate categories such as play lists, genres, artists, albums, tracks after starting the vehicle with the USB device already connected.
   Solution: May occur if very few audio files (less than 70) are stored on the USB device. Disconnect/reconnect the USB device or store more audio files.
- Problem: Message "Reading data" is permanently displayed.
   Solution: Make a new selection; disconnect/reconnect the device; and reset vehicle.
- Problem: If a USB stick is connected prior to starting the vehicle, interference is heard instead of the audio track once the vehicle is started.
   Solution: Select a new track manually or skip forward/back.
- There may be malfunctions if a mobile phone is connected to the USB interface and paired with the Bluetooth hands-free system.
- Some mobile phones deactivate Bluetooth if connected to USB.
